ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

- Born in Africa and/or current passport holders of an African country
- Candidates must have (for at least three years) started and grown a social venture / initiative OR pursued a portfolio career focusing on one social / environmental issue
- Demonstrate how a business education can contribute to the wider development of the community within which they work. They will need to illustrate why a business degree at this stage of their career trajectory can help them amplify their impact
- Arrange to have official university transcripts, letters of recommendation and standardized test scores arrive at the University of Oxford by the appropriate application deadline

APPLICATION & DEADLINES

- Candidates must apply and be admitted to both Harambe and Saïd Business School, University of Oxford, as well as apply separately for the Skoll Scholarship after being admitted onto the MBA programme
- Candidates must complete online HEA Application by December 30, 2016:

- Candidates must apply for the Skoll Scholarship (if invited to do so by the Skoll Centre) by March 19, 2017
