THE OXFORD 1+1 MBA

The Oxford 1+1 MBA is a unique opportunity for talented individuals to combine a Master's degree from one of several Oxford University departments with our one-year MBA. As the global business environment becomes increasingly complex and interconnected, this powerful combination allows you to gain deep knowledge and expertise in your specialist field, as well as developing a comprehensive understanding of business, exceptional leadership skills and practical experience.

As a 1+1 MBA student, you will spend your first year completing a Master in your chosen discipline before joining the MBA in your second year. By completing the 1+1 MBA, you will become a dynamic leader who is able to use management practices to translate specific knowledge into practical applications with wide-reaching impact.

ELIGIBLE CANDIDATES

- Born in Africa and/or current passport holders of an African country
- Leadership potential, demonstrated through entrepreneurial experience and motivation
- Academic achievement
- Strong personal character, integrity and commitment
- Intention to focus on addressing world-scale social challenges in your career, either in an existing organisation or through development of a new enterprise
- Ability to envision how to achieve scalable and sustainable solutions to these challenges
- Articulated vision on how the Oxford 1+1 MBA will allow you to fulfil your objectives

APPLICATION & DEADLINES

Candidates must apply and be admitted to both Harambe and University of Oxford.

Oxford:

- Candidates will need to submit two applications, one for the MSc and one for the 1+1 MBA, meeting the entry requirements for both. **Deadline is January 6, 2017.**
- If you have submitted your MSc application, but need more time for the 1+1 MBA, the final deadline is **March 17, 2017**. Please note that most partnering Masters close their applications in January 2017.
- In addition to the Master and MBA applications, you must submit an essay of no more than 500 words addressing this question *'How do you intend to change the world? What does this tell us about you as a person?'*
